NORDIC FOLK ART EXHIBITION/COMPETITION

At the District Convention in June there once again will be Nordic FOLK ART EXHIBIT & COMPETITION. Besides winners in each category, there also will be a "BEST OF SHOW" Award (selected by the judges) and a "PEOPLES CHOICE" Award (selected by visitors to the exhibit). During the 3 days of convention, delegates will be able to enjoy seeing all the beautiful Nordic Folk Arts on display in the exhibit room. Lodge members may bring their Folk Art to the Convention or send it with a Delegate. They may choose to Exhibit Only or enter the item (s) for Competition. If you would like to enter something, contact Karen Fried for a registrattion form. The Form should be completed for each item to be en-tered.

I. Eligibility

- a. Any Sons of Norway member is eligible to exhibit and/or compete.
- b. Children/Grandchildren of Sons of Norway members may submit a folk art. Youth (ages 16-20 may exhibit and/ or compete. Children ages 15 and below may enter for Exhibition only
- c. If youth folk art entered in competition, it will be judged separately.
- d. An entrant is allowed to enter a maximum of two articles in each category.
- e. All items submitted must have been make by the person who enters it and must have been finished within the past two years.

INGREDIENTS For the pastry

3 1/2 Tbsp. sugar 3/4 cup flour 1/3 cup margarine

For the cream puffs

2/3 cup water 3 Tbsp. margarine 1/2 cup flour 2 eggs

For the filling

2 egg yolks or 1 egg
1 1/2 Tbsp. sugar
1 3/4 Tbsp. corn starch
1 cup full-fat whole milk
2-3 Tbsp. rum
Scant 1/2 cup whipping cream
12-14 cocktail cherries

RECIPE

For the Pastry

- 1. Combine sugar and flour and cut in the margarine.
- 2. Knead lightly. Form into a ball, wrap in plastic. Chill 1 hour. Preheat the oven to 210 C (425 F).

For the Cream Puffs

- 1. Bring water and margarine to a boil.
- 2. Add the flour and stir until the mixture forms a ball.
- 3. Remove from the heat. Cool slightly, then beat in the eggs, one at a time.
- 4. The mixture should be thick enough to just keep its shape. Make 12-14 balls with a spoon and place far apart on a greased baking sheet.
- 5. Roll out the pastry. Cut out round cookies with a 6-7 cm (2 1/2") cutter. Drape them over the balls and press carefully against the baking sheet. 6. Bake until golden, 25-30 minutes.

For the filling

- 1. Whisk together eggs, sugar, cornstarch and milk in a saucepan.
- 2. Heat to boiling, stirring constantly, but do not allow to boil. Cool, stirring occasionally.
- 3. Stir in rum. Whip the cream and fold into the rum mixture.
- 4. Puncture the bottom of the cream puffs. Fill a pastry tube with rum cream and pipe the mixture into the cream puffs. Top each with a cherry




